Drug deaths nationwide hit a new record in 2022

 109,680 people died from an overdose and the fentanyl crisis continued to deepen, according to preliminary data released by CDC

 Only 1 in 10 Americans experiencing addiction currently get medical treatment

Vaping caused North Texas teen's lungs to fail, doctors say



Tryston Zohfeld is 17 years old and told WFAA that he's been vaping since the 8th grade, sometimes going through two to three vaping pods a week.

FORT WORTH, Texas — A 17-year-old Weatherford High School graduate is recovering after doctors in Fort Worth determined excessive vaping caused the teen's lungs to fail, sparking an 18-day stay in the hospital.

The teen told WFAA that he had chills, an elevated heart rate, was tired, and that he had been vomiting.

"I woke up just throwing up everywhere, and my heart was beating out of my chest going 100 miles an hour," Zohfeld said.


Electronic Nicotine Delivery Systems (ENDS)

• Vaporizers, vape pens, hookah pens, electronic cigarettes, e-pipes, mods, juuls, etc.



Cilia line and protect the lungs, blocking debris

Burning the cilia or damaging them increases likelihood of getting sick





Oils and Damage...

 Nicotine or THC, the high-inducing chemical in marijuana, is mixed with solvents that dissolve and deliver the drugs

 The solvents, or oils, heat up during aerosolization to become vapor

- Oil droplets may be left over as the liquid cools back down
 - inhaling those drops may cause breathing problems and lung inflammation



Nicotine Poisoning and Kids

Nicotine poisoning can be fatal

E-liquids, containing even small amounts of <u>nicotine</u>, can be dangerous to children if they touch or drink it

From April 2022 to March 2023, there were **7,043 e-cigarette or e-liquid exposure cases** reported, with approximately **88% of exposures occurring among children under 5 years old**

Nicotine Poisoning and Pets

- Nicotine poisoning is a serious concern for pets
 - Inhaled or ingested
- How could your pet ingest nicotine?
 - Eating cigarette or cigar butts, drinking nicotine refill liquid, chewing on nicotine refill canisters for ENDS, or chewing on the devices themselves
- Nicotine can be toxic even in small doses Fatal doses in dogs and cats have been reported at 20 to 100 milligrams
- How much of a tobacco product would a dog or cat have to eat to reach a dose of 20 to 100 mg?
 - One regular cigarette can contain 9 to 30 mg
 - One cigar can contain 15 to 40 mg


- In 2009, the FDA passed the Family Smoking Prevention and Tobacco Control Act, banning all flavored cigarettes with the exception of menthol
- This was done to address the youth-targeted appeal of tobacco
- The ban was an important first step for responsible tobacco regulation to protect the American public, particularly children, from the dangers of cigarettes
- However, other tobacco products such as cigars, chewing tobacco, blunt wraps and shisha are still sold in candy flavors such as bubble gum, strawberry, grape and mango

• "The teen brain is actively developing and often will not be fully developed until the mid 20s," the CDC stated


Butane Honey Oil (BHO) Dabs, Wax, Budder, Shatter

- Cooked like meth; acts like meth: psychotic breaks
- Passing butane through a tube packed with marijuana
- Leaves extracted resin behind as a sticky, thick oil—like substance
- Up to 90% THC Potency



More Potency = More Likelihood of Risk



- Hurts teen brain development
- Can impair judgement
- Addiction
- Contributes to depression and anxiety
- Panic attacks, delusions and violent outbursts

INHALANTS

Butane

- ✓ It can cause severe psychotic episodes even among individuals with no previous psychiatric illness.
- ✓ It is more common among those that abuse butane, especially those that use it regularly over an extended time span.
- ✓ Butane-induced psychosis could produce symptoms such as: violence, persecutory delusions, and visual hallucinations

Wax cooks = "Boom!"



- Wax is to marijuana as freebasing is to cocaine or heroin and what the shake-and-bake method is to meth



Where Is Fentanyl Being Found In Vapes?

- Greatest concern among HS students, millions of whom report current e-cigarette use (according to the CDC)
- A school superintendent in Eldridge, Iowa confirmed confiscation of a vape with THC and fentanyl at a HS in the Quad Cities area in February
- In Pennsylvania, school administration reported confiscating 3 vape pens that tested positive for fentanyl or heroin
- In the aftermath of that confiscation, a school official told local news that fentanyl-related overdoses linked to laced vape liquid are rising throughout the country

Fentanyl Concerns and Youth

- Bags of fentanyl in a public-school classroom should evoke the same alarm as a school shooting or a bomb scare
 - The quantity could kill as many innocent students
- No time to be addicts

- Dead in one use
 - Fentanyl is 80 to 100 times stronger than morphine
 - Teens risking death on the first try... No second chance
 - Fentanyl kills so fast that by the time first responders arrive, often there's no pulse

Fentanyl in US - 2022

- Over 50.6 million pills seized in US = 379 million deadly doses
 - Last year it was 20.4 million nationally
 - 10,000 pounds of powder
- 6 out of 10 fentanyl laced fake prescription pills contain a lethal dose of fentanyl
 - AZ pills are lethal dose higher than average
- \$1-\$5 on street
 - 35 cents per pill in bulk (wholesale)
- "Golden Trails" high purity when pills burn golden on foil



Over 50% of fentanyl entering US coming through Arizona: DEA

- 51.4% of all the fentanyl entering the U.S. is coming through Arizona
 - About 1/2 of that is coming from the southeast corner of AZ
- California is responsible for 46.3% of the fentanyl entering the U.S
 - Texas and New Mexico barely register with just 1% of drug seizures
- The new DEA data shows more than 20 million pills were seized in Maricopa County in 2022

So Far in 2023...

DEA Fentanyl Seizures in 2023

In 2022, DEA seized more than 58.4 million fentanyl-lace fake pills and more than 13,000 pounds of fentanyl powder. The 2022 seizures are equivalent to more than 387.6 million lethal doses of fentanyl.

The 2023 fentanyl seizures represent over 190 million deadly doses. *



Deputies with the Multnomah County Special Investigations Unit in Oregon deputies say they found a new form of fentanyl that is considered to be more dangerous and potent than pressed pills. (Multnomah County Sheriff's Department)







PORTLAND, Ore. (KATU) — Deputies in an Oregon county said they found 800 pills of fentanyl and four grams of multi-colored, powdered fentanyl, which is often referred to as "rainbow fentanyl," while they search a suspect's house.

Police said the Multnomah County Special Investigations Unit also found body armor, \$5,000 in cash, nine guns, some of which were modified and stolen, and drugs, including meth, heroin, and fentanyl.



Snap + Counterfeit Pills = Death

At around 1:30 a.m. on Aug. 15, 2020, Zachariah Plunk, 17, a star high school football player from Mesa, Ariz., contacted a dealer through Snapchat, seeking a Percocet.

As footage from the family's home security camera would reveal, the dealer dropped off drugs around 3 a.m. Zach went outside, swallowed a pill and fell to the curb. At 5 a.m., a 15-year-old neighbor found him dead.

Middle-school children fall prey to fatal fentanyl overdoses

- Though still rare, drug deaths among children ages 10 to 14 more than tripled from 2019 to 2020, according to an analysis done for CNN by the US CDC
- Unintentional drug overdoses led to 200,000 years of lost life for US preteens and teens who died between 2015 and 2019, a January study found. And experts suspect that the problem has gotten worse during the pandemic, research shows
- Annual drug overdose deaths have reached another record high in the United States, with an
 estimated 104,288 in the 12-month period ending September 2021, according to provisional
 data published Wednesday by the CDC's National Center for Health Statistics
- That's double the number from six years prior; there were an estimated 52,000 drug overdose deaths annually in September 2015



Deadly Combination: Fentanyl and Xylazine

- "Xylazine is making the deadliest drug threat our country has ever faced, fentanyl, even deadlier," Milgram said. "DEA has seized xylazine and fentanyl mixtures in 48 of 50 States. The DEA Laboratory System is reporting that in 2022 approximately 23% of fentanyl powder and 7% of fentanyl pills seized by the DEA contained xylazine."
- Animal sedative AKA "trang" increase in trafficking of combo
- Narcan ineffective

Nitazenes - "Frankenstein" Opioids

BCI-Bulletin-Vol-18-02-Nitazenes-(Public).aspx (ohioattorneygeneral.gov)

- Nitazenes, a group of dangerous synthetic opioids that can be up to 40 times more potent than fentanyl
- Nitazene compounds were originally synthesized in the 1950s for research of their analgesic effects; however, these substances are not approved for medical use anywhere in the world

Ohio Specific Case Observations

Color: White, off-white, beige, brown, tan, gray, black, yellow, peach, orange, green

Form: Powder, solid substance, liquid from syringes, residues

Adulterants: Found primarily in combination with fentanyl and fentanyl pharmacophores. Also found in combination with tramadol, cocaine, heroin, methamphetamine, benzodiazepine pharmacophores, and PCP analogs. Non-controlled substances that may be present include caffeine, diphenhydramine, mannitol, xylazine, and quinine.

Locations: Ohio BCI Laboratory submissions containing nitazene compounds were received from the counties depicted above.

What is Narcan and how is it used?





Narcan is used for emergency treatment of opioid overdose. It's an opioid antagonist, which means it works by blocking certain receptors in your body that opioids bind to.

By blocking these receptors, Narcan helps to reverse symptoms of opioid overdose

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has approved the first nonprescription over-the-counter naloxone nasal spray (brand name Narcan). According to the National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA), naloxone is a medication designed to rapidly reverse an opioid overdose, which includes fentanyl, heroin, and prescription opioid pain medications (oxycodone, hydrocodone, morphine, etc.).

Sex & Drugs

Trafficking of illegal drugs and human trafficking often happen together

- Transnational drug traffickers and criminal organizations often look to increase profits and market control through diversification
 - Using trafficking routes for drugs, labor, sex, and violence
- For traffickers, it doesn't matter which product is being sold -- both drugs and sex are lucrative industries – as long as money is made
 - Drug cartels often use trafficked women and children to smuggle drugs across the border, doubling up on the money they can make from them
- Violent criminals like this see no difference between abusing a woman's body by forcing her to swallow bags of drugs or by forcing her to have sex with hundreds of men

Lost Daughters of Mexico

• When a girl is *robada* – which literally means stolen – she is taken off the street, on her way to school, leaving the movies, or even stolen out of her own house. No ransom is asked for. **Her body is all the criminals want**

 The drug cartels know they can sell a bag of drugs only once, but they can prostitute a young woman many times in a single day

Human Trafficking & The Opioid Crisis

Human traffickers often use drugs as "bait" to recruit people who
have a substance use disorder. Traffickers use drugs as a means of
control over their victims – to force compliance, harder work, longer
hours, or to keep them "drugged out" so they do not attempt escape

 Criminals forcing women and children into addiction by providing them strong and potent drugs as a means of exerting control

About 25% of human trafficking survivors have an opioid problem









Sex and labor trafficking industry is second only to drug trafficking as the world's largest criminal industry, according to the International Labour Organization and the nonprofit Polaris Project.

1. Say "NO THANKS."

The easiest but some forget to try it. This often works when you are faced with friendly or teasing pressure.



2. Give a Reason, Fact or Excuse.

The excuse needs to get you away from the person or situation. Practice an excuse so that you won't hesitate and will sound confident. Have a code word to use with your parents. Text them the word and have them call to say you need to come home.

"My mom just called. Sorry...I gotta go. Something's going on at home".

"My parents would ground me for life"

"I forgot that I have a doctor's appt. this afternoon"

"I already lost my phone privileges. If they find me doing this stuff I won't be able to go anywhere for a month!"



3. Walk Away.

One of the most effective refusal skills is just too walk away. You may feel obligated to stand and face "the enemy" but you need to just leave. Say no and walk away while saying it.



4. Change the Subject.

You can offer another alternative activity: "No. Let's go play ball instead" or "Let's go get a snack at my house. I'm hungry." or "I wanted to play my Xbox this afternoon"



5. Use Humor.

"No thanks. This stuff stunts my growth. I want to be tall to play ball."

"Man, I need all the brain cells I can get. No thanks."

"Pot makes you stupid and gives you yellow teeth..!'ll pass."



6. Broken Record or Repeated Refusal.

Keep saying "no" over and over again. It will buy you some time to use another refusal technique or be an annoyance.



7. Cold Shoulder or Ignore.

Avoid directly confronting the person. Turn your shoulder and talk to someone else or just ignore them like you don't hear them.



8. Avoid the Situation.

Common sense tells you the places and times where there may be problems with peer pressure. Avoid these situations.




9. Strength in numbers.

The truth is simple. If you surround yourself with friends that make good choices then you will too. The opposite is true as well. One of your most important choices you can make is the choice of your friends. Choose to hang out with non-users.

Studies have found...



- Dog owners are less likely to suffer from depression than those without pets
- People with dogs have lower blood pressure in stressful situations than those without pets. One study even found that when people with borderline hypertension adopted dogs from a shelter, their blood pressure declined significantly within five months
- Playing with a dog or cat can elevate levels of serotonin and dopamine, which calm and relax
- Pet owners have lower triglyceride and cholesterol levels (indicators of heart disease) than those without pets
- Heart attack patients with dogs survive longer than those without
- Pet owners over age 65 make 30 percent fewer visits to their doctors than those without pets




